## 2015 Summer State Championship Meet

Lander's stellar swimming performances continued this past weekend at Wyoming's 2015 Summer Long Course A & B Championships in Gillette, Wyoming. Seventeen Lander swimmers, ages 5 to 16, competed in a 50-meter pool in multiple events, securing a second place finish in Division II.

Lander did especially well in individual events with Finn Richards placing 1st overall in the boys 8&Under age group, receiving the high point award and Jonny Kulow winning the high point award in the boys 10&Under age group. The audience was stunned by the spectacular swims of Jonny Kulow, who broke a total of six state long course records, several of which were originally set in the 1980's. Head Coach Jennifer Schaff said of Jonny, "We love his enthusiasm and energy in the water. He works hard in practice and thrives on competition."

Lander swimmers had many 1st place finishes by multiple members of the team including Finn Richards and Jonny Kulow sweeping the events they swam. Other first place finishes were by Ryan Brinda, Caleb Huelskamp, Dylan Huelskamp, and the 12&Under boys relay team. The 12&Under 200-meter medley team consisted of J. Kulow, D. Huelskamp, B. Kulow, and F. Richards. The 12&Under 200-meter free relay team consisted of J. Kulow, D. Huelskamp, B. Kulow, and N. Larson.

Four of the club's 13-14 girls, Fowler, Gose, Lilygren, and McPherson, competed strongly in one of the most competitive age groups in the state, and their relay team placed 5th in both the 400-meter medley relay and 400-meter free relay. The boys relay team of Brinda, C. Huelskamp, N. Kulow, and Roy competed in the Open age group against swimmers who were mostly older than them and won 4th place in the 400-meter medley relay and 3rd place in the 400-meter free relay.
